FRIDAY

Canoe Ceremony Blessing

Being held at South Burnie Yacht Club

SATURDAY

OC6 MARATHON 15KM

Starting at the East Wynyard beach and heading up the Inglis River turning at the buoy and head back to Somerset Surf Life Saving Club.

SUNDAY

OC1 & OC2 MARATHON 10KM

Starting at the South Burnie Yacht Club and heading left to the end of the break water. Paddle along the back of the break water towards Burnie. Head along in front of the Burnie Surf Club and to the point of West Park oval, turn at the buoy and head back towards Burnie along the back of the break water towards Wivenhoe, turn at the buoy and head back to South Burnie Yacht Club where the race started.

OC6 500M & 1000M SPRINTS, OC1 & OC2 250M SPRINTS

All sprints will be held at South Burnie Yacht Club.

OC6 SPRINTS OVER 250M COURSE

OC1 & OC2 SPRINTS 250M COURSE

OC2 5KM MIXED MARATHON

Start at South Burnie Yacht Club out around beacon, head towards Round Hill turn buoy and return to start / finish line.

COMPETITORS

Conditions of Eligibility

1. Each competitor must be a financial member of an AOCRA Affiliated Club.
2. Membership status must be in place by 2 weeks prior to the regatta, as evidenced by the completed member application and annual AOCRA fees received by the AOCRA Victoria Zone.
3. Lifejackets must be worn in all races without exception to comply with our permits for operating at South Burnie, Wynyard and Somerset. Any non-compliance will be automatic disqualification.
4. OC6 Covers are required for every race. (except sprints)
5. Tow rope, Bailers (2), spare paddle must be fitted to each OC6.
6. OC1 & OC2 races – a leg rope must be worn.
7. Clubs are encouraged to enter crews by paddler age category ie. Open, Masters or Senior crews in addition to / or instead of, Open crews, because Zone points will be awarded by Division.
8. Awards will only be for overall 1st, 2nd, 3rd, across the line.
